MUSIC FOR A WHILE: INAUGURAL CONCERT ON THE GRAY ORGAN AT HOLY CROSS, TOPSHAM. Thursday 14 September at 6.30 p.m. The 18th century organ which was recently installed at Holy Cross was inaugurated and blessed on 4 June. The first concert on the Gray organ will be given by John Wellingham, specialist in historic organs and playing technique for early instruments. He will play a programme of 17th and 18th century organ music, including pieces by Bach, Stanley, Purcell, Gibbons and Marcello. Seating is limited at Holy Cross.
