**The Chrism Mass only happens once a year – the Wednesday of Holy Week, and only at the Cathedral in Plymouth. If you've never celebrated it, you're missing one of the most solemn and significant liturgies of our church.** Two meaningful rituals occur during this Mass. The first is the renewal of the vows and commitment to the priesthood by all the priests and Bishop Mark. The second is the blessing and distribution of the Holy Oils. Here Bishop Mark blesses three oils — the oil of catechumens, the oil of the infirm, and holy chrism — which will be used in the administration of the

sacraments in our parish and throughout the diocese for the year. **There are a few spaces left on the mini bus** going to this mass on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March. If you would like to join me please contact the office ASAP.
